



Webcam Videos

Use the laptop or netbook webcam to capture video footage for student projects!

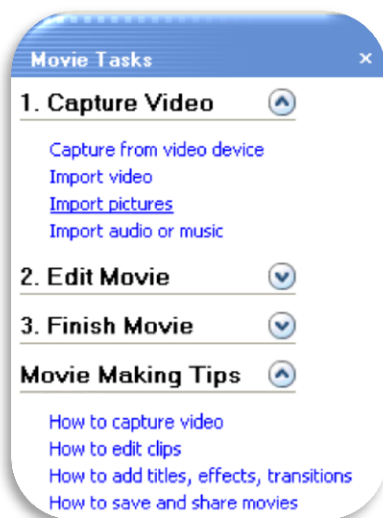
Step 1

Double click the My Computer icon on the computer desktop and check that the USB Video Device icon is present. If it is not present, activate the webcam using the identified key on your device keyboard.



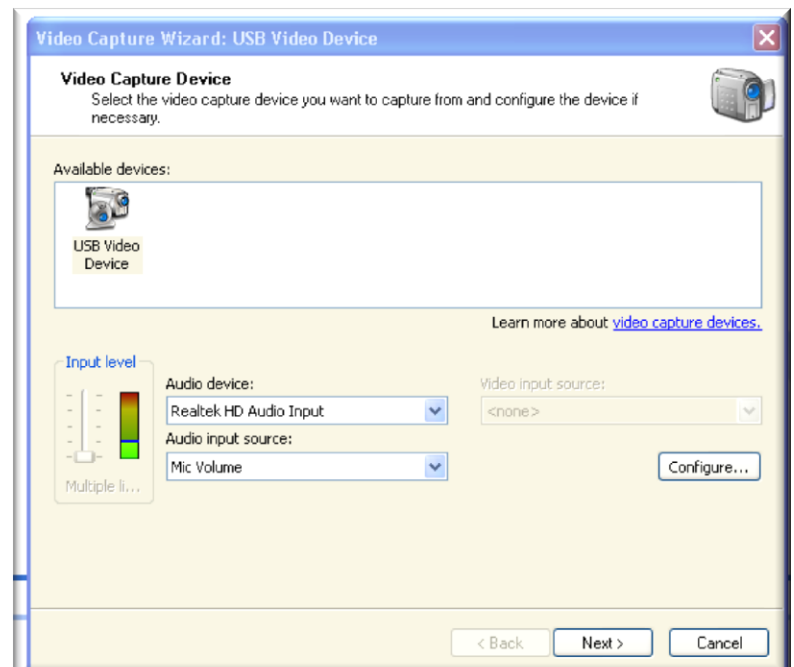
Step 2

Access the MovieMaker program from the Tools folder on the computer desktop. Double click to open the program.



Step 3

Click the Capture from Video Device link in the Movie Tasks pane on the left side.



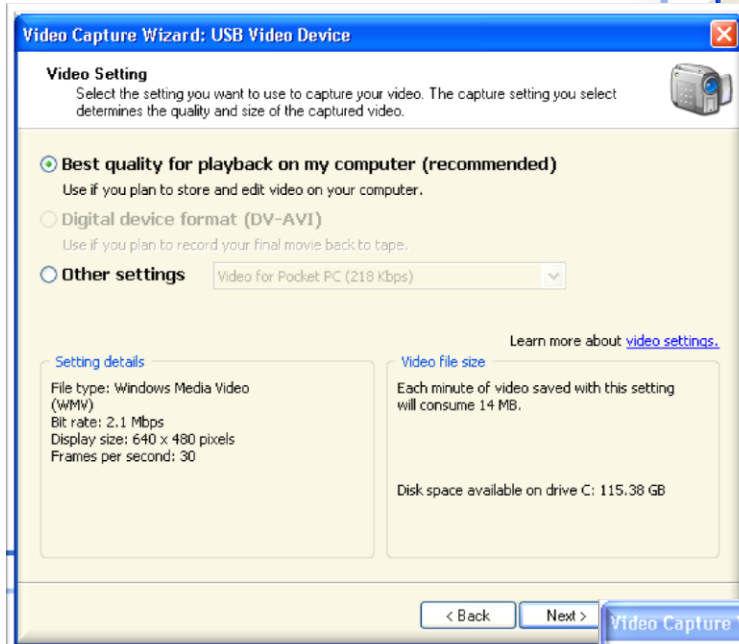
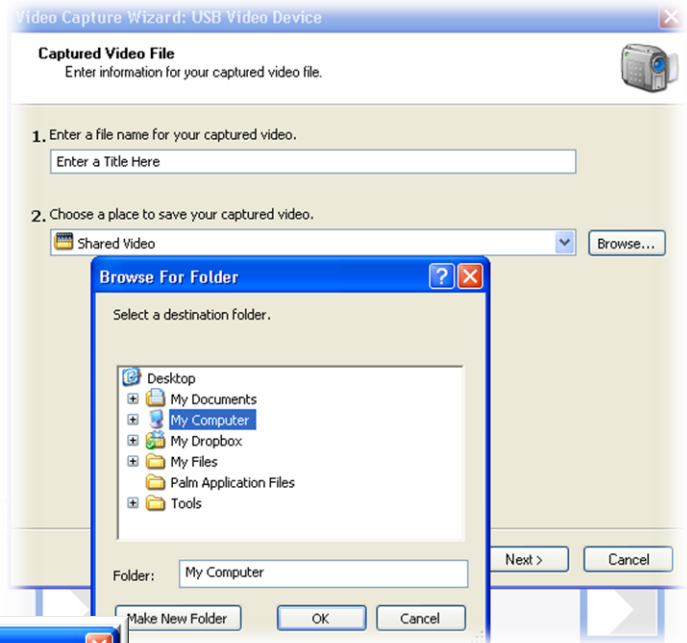
Step 4

Test the microphone input by speaking and watching the input level indicator. Adjust as needed and then click the Next button.



Step 5

Enter a file name for the video and click the Browse button to select the location to which the completed video will be saved and then click the Next button.

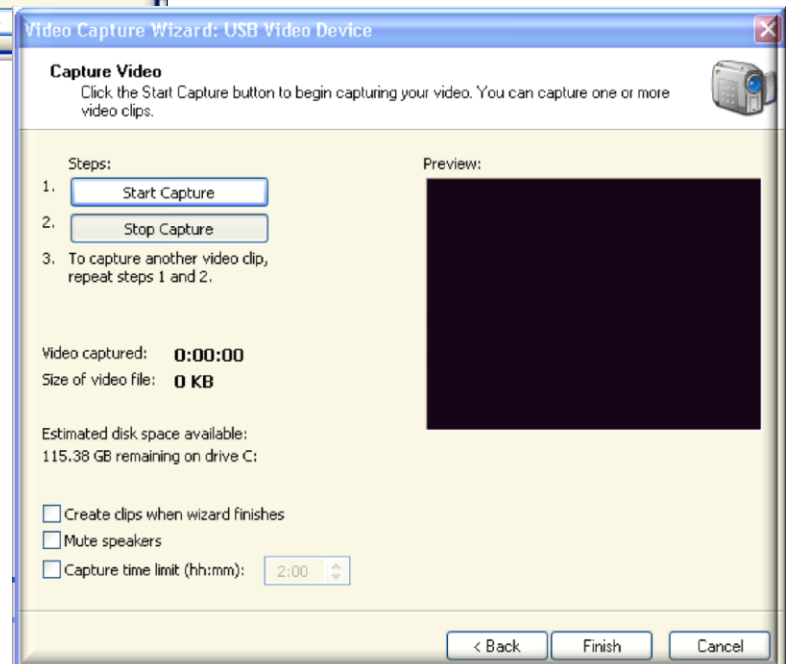


Step 6

Choose the Best quality for playback video setting option and click the Next button.

Step 7

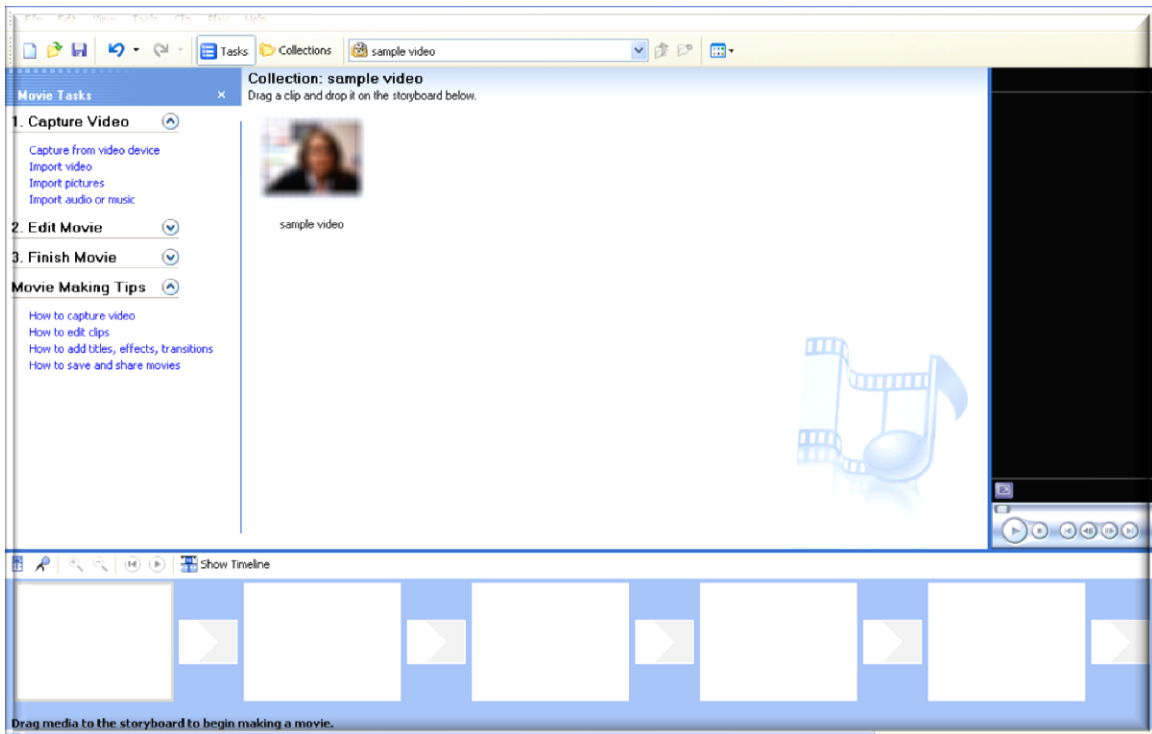
Review the Capture Video settings. It is recommended to uncheck the Create clips checkbox before capturing. Click the Start Capture button and the Stop Capture when finished. Then click the Finish button.





After Capturing

The completed video file can be found in the previously identified location. If the video will be edited, drag the clip from the collection area to the storyboard/timeline at the bottom and edit away!



After Editing

Once editing is completed, click File>Save Movie File and complete the options. The final video will be saved to a location of your choosing.
